After a grueling 19-hour day [this past Sunday, June 15], we are officially one hour away from our hotel in Wenatchee as I write this. The one rule of Amtrak travel is to: expect the unexpected and that has stood true!

Below you'll find a recap of our day!

4:45am CT - Said farewell at the airport!

6:55am CT - Departed MSP.

8:45am PT (10:45am CT) - Landed in Seattle-Tacoma and made our way to regional transport. This was the first train of the day. Similar to Metro Transit in Minneapolis, the light rail took us directly downtown where we had a three-minute walk to King Street Station.

10:30am PT - We walked through downtown Seattle including Pioneer Square to reach Pikes Place market.

11:00am PT - We ate lunch together at Soundview Diner.

12:00pm PT - The group split into two smaller sections where we wandered around the market.

12:45pm PT - We rejoined to sit outside of the market and enjoy the sun. From there we walked back to Pioneer Square.

1:45pm PT - Some wanted to also see a bookstore!

4:45pm PT - Boarded our train to Wenatchee. We were all settled in when...



5:00pm PT - ... the train stops! We were delayed about an hour, when we finally started going again, traveling east through the Cascade Mountains.

9:27pm PT (11:27 CT) - The conductor just passed through to announce we are a half hour to Wenatchee, so we are almost there!

Tomorrow, travel continues. An early wake up call followed by bus and boat rides will culminate in our arrival at Holden Village, [where] we won't have cell reception.
